

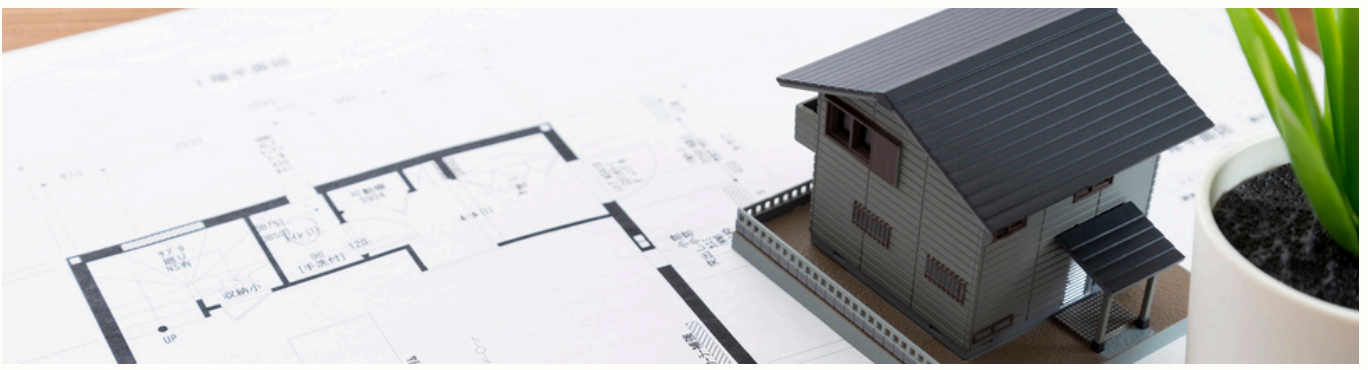
DIRECTIONS OF ORIENTATIONS OF A PROPERTY
